



The **prof\*panel** is a longitudinal survey with the aim of examining the various **career paths to professorship**.

The first survey took place in summer 2022. We have compiled a first\* peek at the data for you to look, among other things, at one of the newer paths to professorship in Germany, the **tenure track**.

Almost 3000 people participated, of which **N = 2126** were included in this first data teaser.

\* Provisional data, subject to change.

**Respondents** have an average of **1.4 children**.  
**18,4 %** of respondents hold a **tenure track professorship**.  
 The most common pay grade for tenure track among the respondents is **W1** (72,9 %), and for the remaining proportion it is W2.  
**Tenure track professors** surveyed are on average **38 years old** and thus 2 years younger than junior professors without tenure track.
