

Respondents have an average of 1.4 children.

18,4 % of respondents hold a tenure track professorship.

The most common pay grade for tenure track among the respondents is W1 (72,9 %), and for the remaining proportion it is W2.

Tenure track professors surveyed are on average

38 years old and thus 2 years younger
than junior professors without tenure track.



The **prof*panel** is a longitudinal survey with the aim of examining the various **career paths to professorship**.

The first survey took place in summer 2022. We have compiled a first* peek at the data for you to look, among other things, at one of the newer paths to professorship in Germany, the **tenure track**.

Almost 3000 people participated, of which **N = 2126** were included in this first data teaser.
